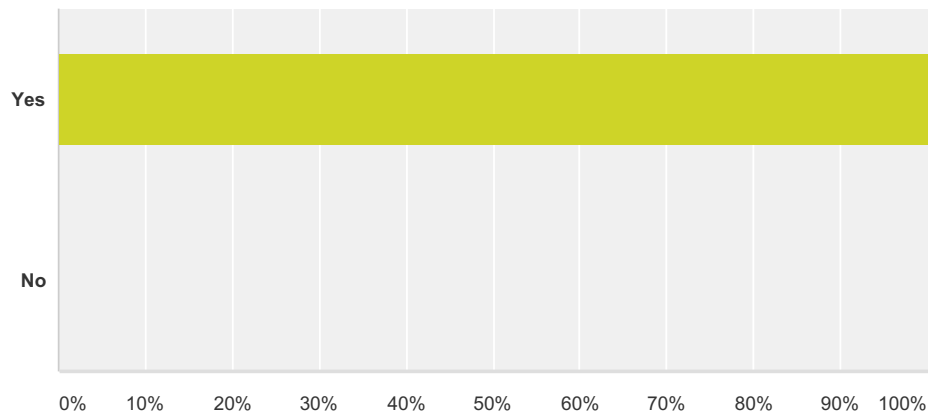


### Q1 Have you attended an IACE quarterly training session at the Centre of Elgin?

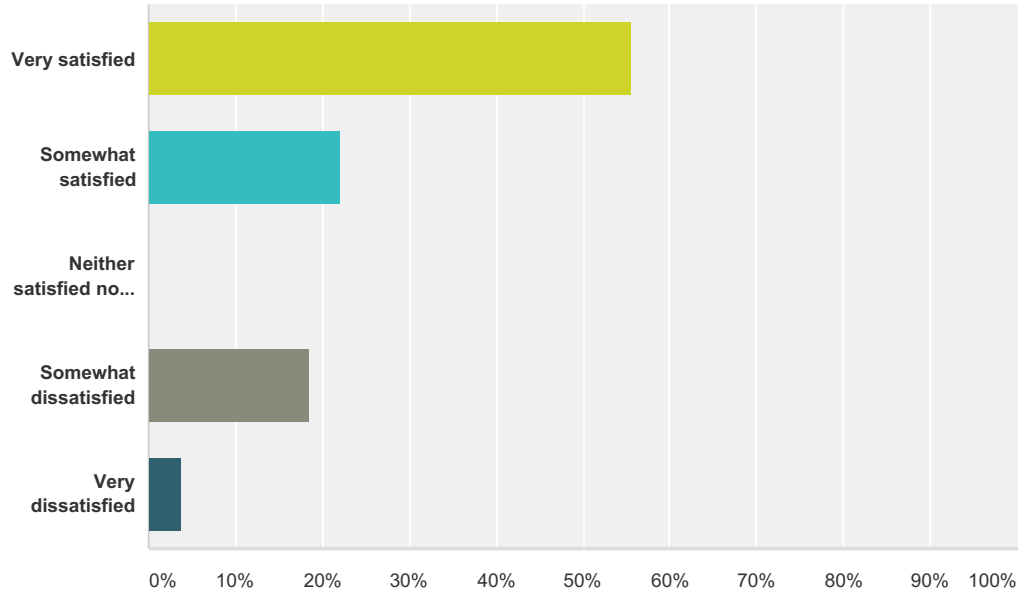

### Q2 Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the Centre of Elgin as a venue for IACE quarterly training sessions?

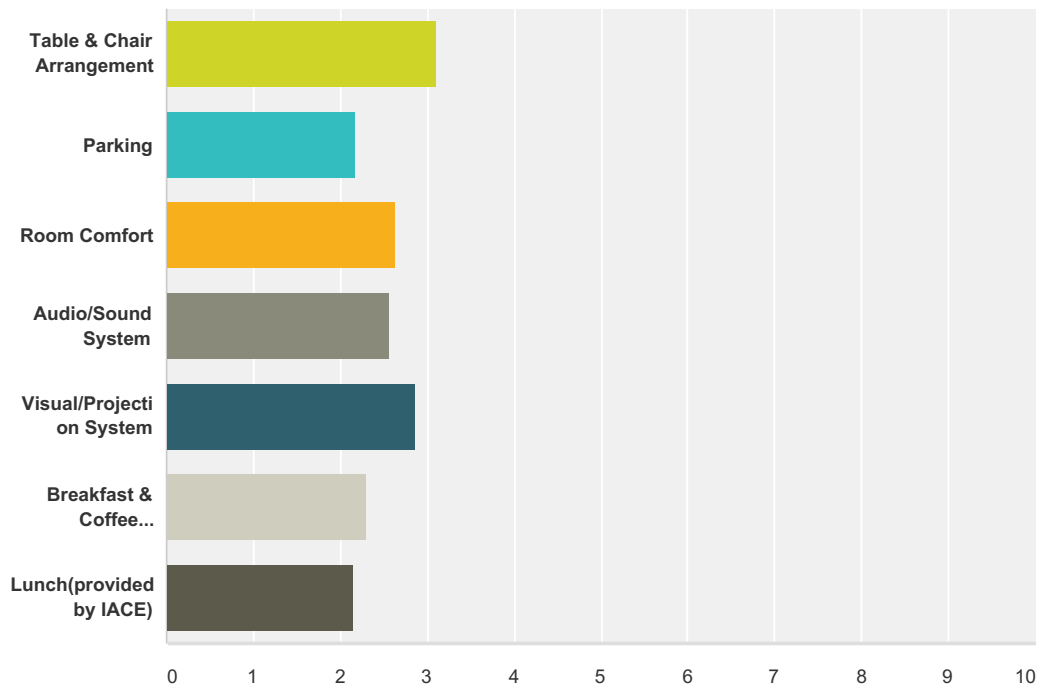

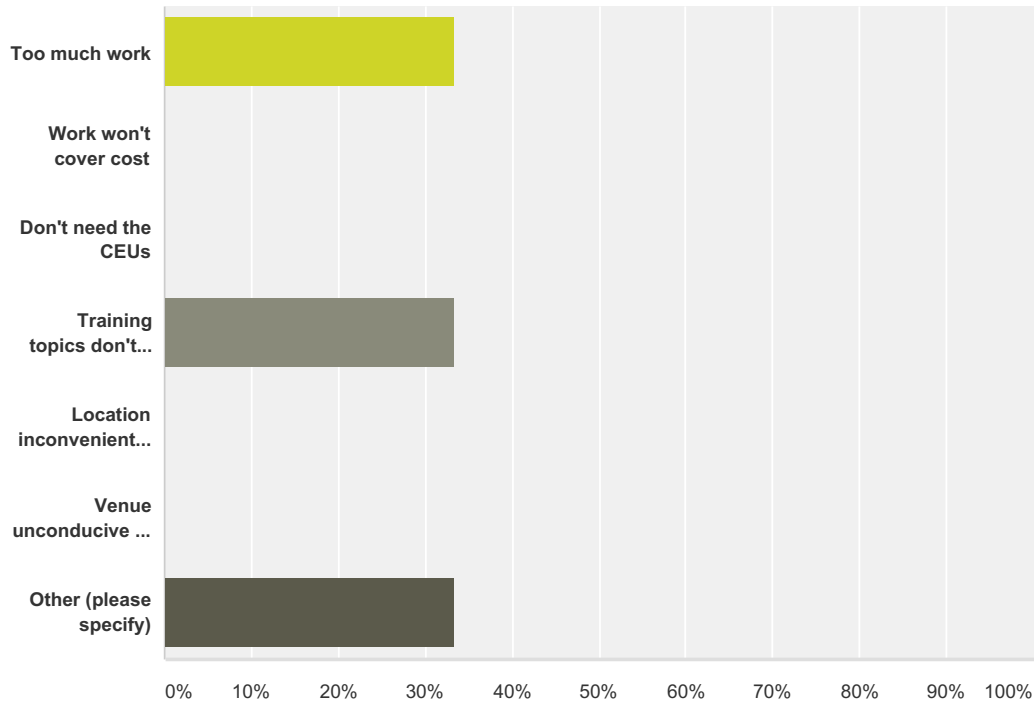

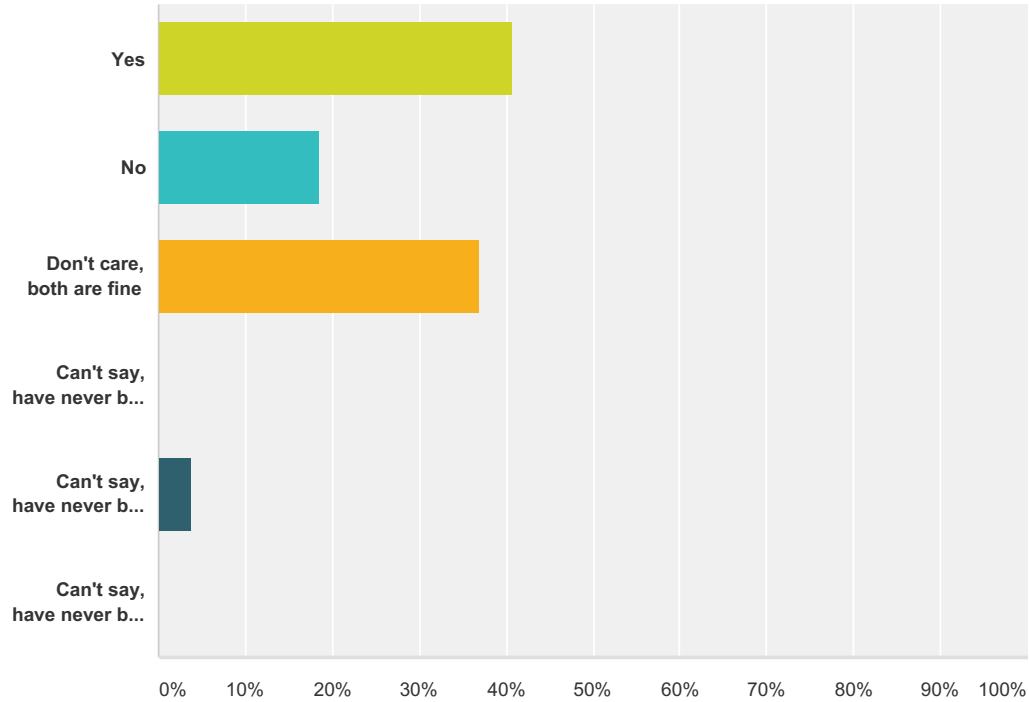

### Q7 Would you prefer to have quarterly training sessions at Elgin Community College (ECC) instead of the Centre of Elgin?

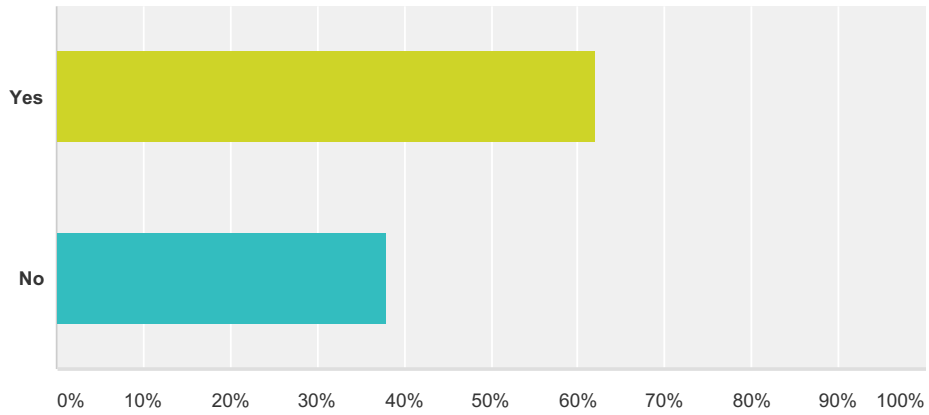

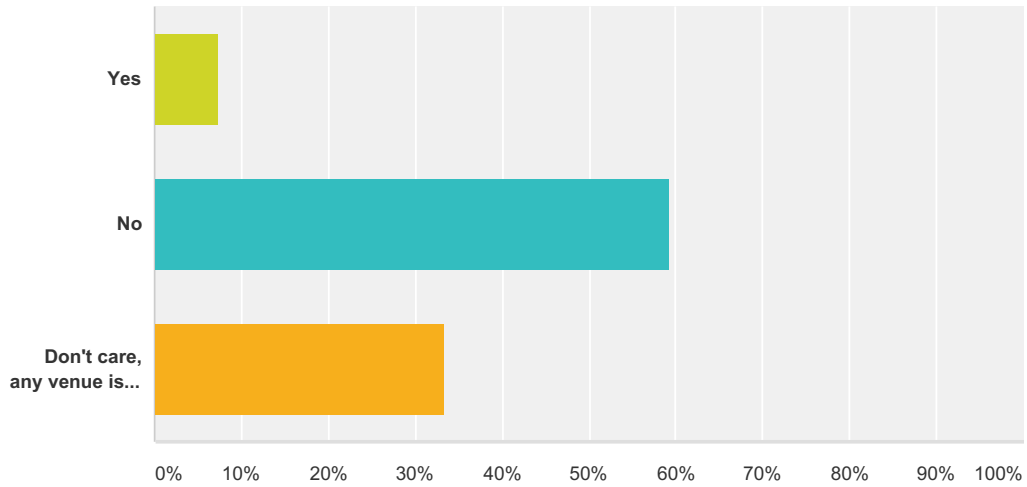

### Q9 Would you prefer to have quarterly training sessions at some venue other than the Centre of Elgin or Elgin Community College?

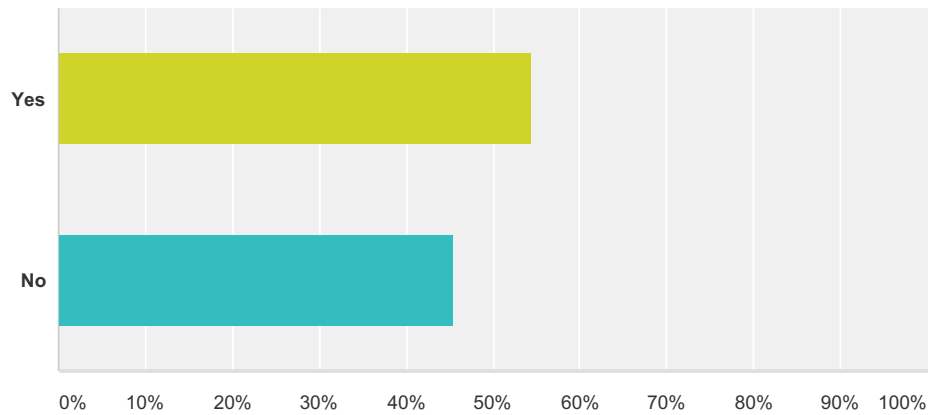

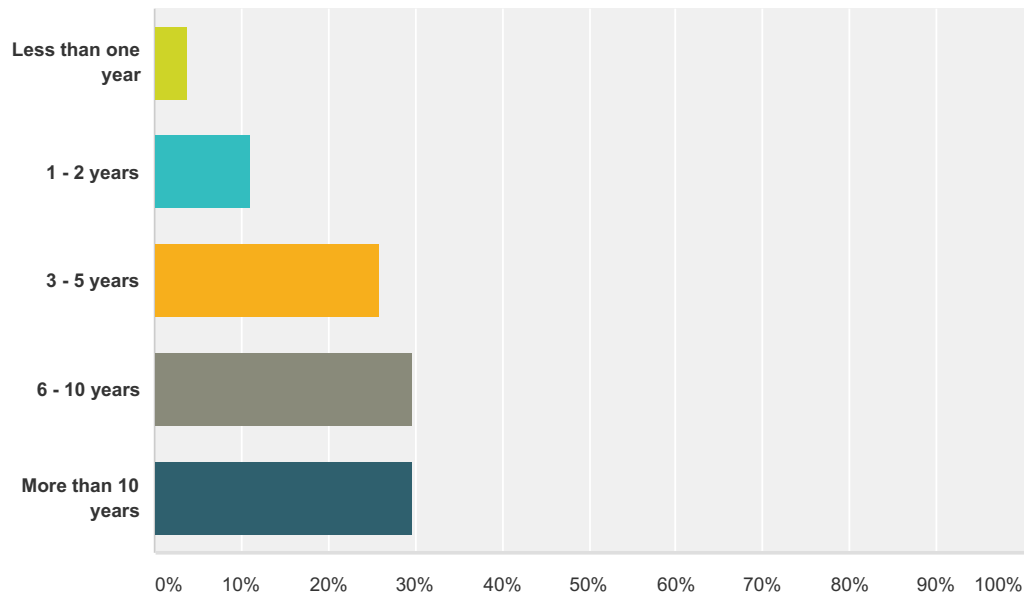
